

ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

W0048 / W0124 / W0310

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER WHILE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

NOTES: 1. Before installing, consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirements.

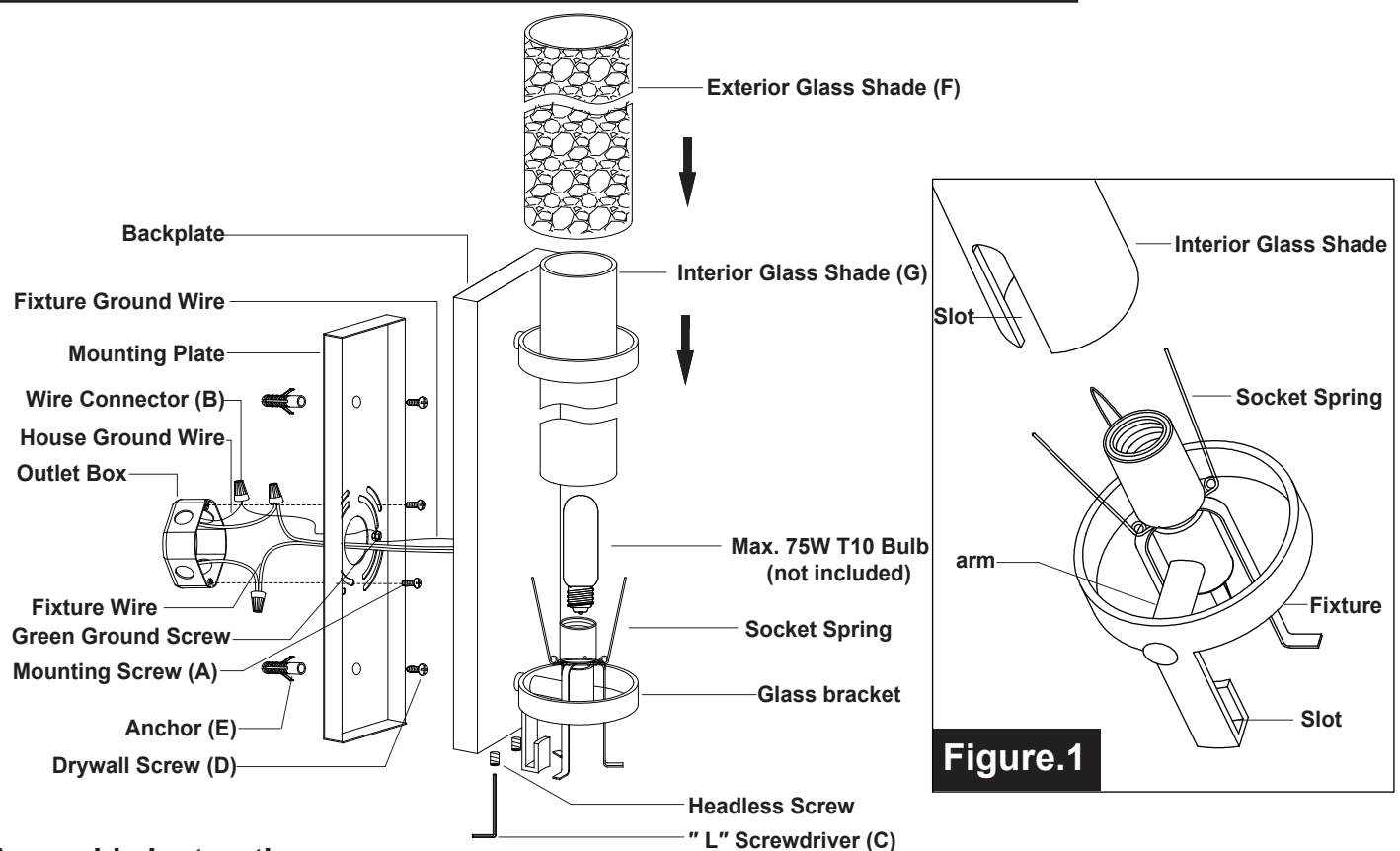
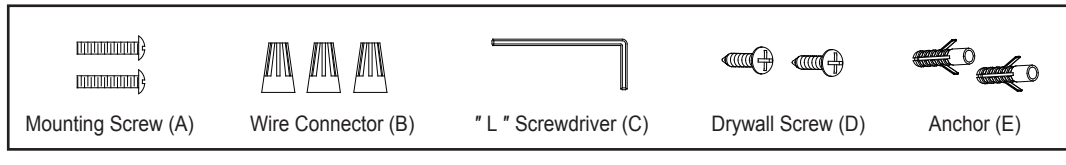

Assembly Instructions:

Turn off the power at fuse

1. Unscrew the headless screws from backplate by using "L" screwdriver (C), then remove the mounting plate.
2. Attach the mounting plate to the wall.
 - a) If the wall material is wood:
Attach the mounting plate to the outlet box by using two mounting screws (A), then secure the drywall screws (D) through the set holes to the wall.
 - b) If the wall material is cement:
Place the mounting plate to the outlet box and mark the target on the wall from the set hole for drilling two holes. Remove the mounting plate. Drill the holes and thread the anchors (E) into the holes, then attach the mounting plate to the outlet box by using two mounting screws (A). Secure the drywall screws (D) through the set holes into the anchors (E).

3. Pull out the source wires from the outlet box. Make wire connections using wire connectors (B) as follows:
 - Connect the black (hot) wire from the fixture to the black (hot) wire from the power source.
 - Connect the white (neutral) wire from the fixture to the white (neutral) wire from the power source.
 - Attach the fixture ground wire to the mounting plate with the green ground screw, then connect it to the house ground wire with a wire connector (B). If your outlet box does not have a house ground wire, then wrap the fixture ground wire around the green ground screw.
 Carefully put the wires back into the outlet box.
4. Attach the backplate to the mounting plate, secure the headless screws from the bottom hole of the backplate onto the bottom side of the mounting plate, using supplied "L" screwdriver (C).
5. Install the bulb (not included). See relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum wattage allowed.
6. Press in the three socket springs. Slide the interior glass shade (G) over the socket springs and into the glass bracket. Adjust the slot in the interior glass shade (G) over the arm from the backplate. Slide the exterior glass shade (F) over the interior glass shade (G) and into the glass bracket. Adjust the slot in the exterior glass shade (F) over the arm from the backplate.

Turn on the power at the main fuse or circuit breaker box.

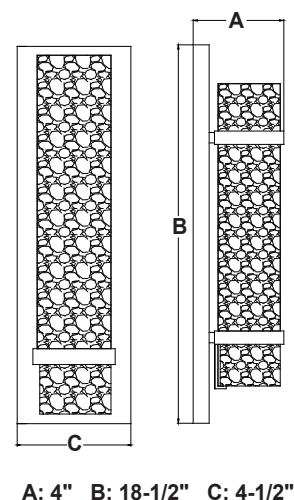
